



## Alan Jon Drummond

Alan Jon Drummond at the age of 82 passed from his earthly home in Hurricane, Utah on December 17, 2022. He was surrounded by his loving wife and family members.

Alan was born in Lyons, Nebraska on June 8, 1940 to very wonderful parents Clarence John Drummond and May Alta Peterson. Alan and Ronda were married in Modesto, California on August 2, 1987.
