Alice Morgan passed away peacefully on October 22, 2025, at the age of 87, of natural causes in Washington, Utah. She was born on March 30, 1938, in Chicago, Illinois, to Albert and Dolly McCarthy.

Alice's strong will and resilience served her well throughout her life as she faced ongoing health challenges with courage.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Russell; her son, Steve; her parents, Albert and Dolly McCarthy; her sister, Sue; and her brother, Denny. She is survived by her sisters, Bonnie (Joe), and Pat; her children, Dan (Cindy), Bill (Manoah), and Jenny (John); grandchildren, Jessica (Maria), Daniel (Renee), Kelsey (Ryan) and Michael (Shaylee), and great-grandchildren, Benjamin, Lyra, Cassandra, Roman, and Porter.
