Amanda Elizabeth Volcansek, age 48, passed away peacefully in her home on December 17, 2025, in Hurricane, Utah, surrounded by love.

Amanda was born on September 30, 1977, in Provo, Utah, to D. Clive Winn and Kathy Winn. Her childhood was shaped by adventure and adaptability as her family moved frequently due to her father's service with the FBI, living in Texas, California, and the Chicago area before settling in Orem, Utah. There, Amanda attended high school and graduated in 1995. Shortly thereafter, she moved into an apartment with her beloved older sister, Aubrey, beginning a season of independence and growth.

Amanda spent several years in Provo, Utah, where she earned a degree in Family and Human Development from Brigham Young University. During this time, she also served faithfully as an ordinance worker in the Provo Temple, a role she cherished deeply.

Following graduation, Amanda fulfilled a long-held desire to work at Kids On The Move, where she served in early intervention, working with children under the age of three diagnosed with autism. Her work reflected her gentle

strength, patience, and profound love for children.

In 2003, Amanda met the love of her life, Jonathan “Jonny” Volcansek. Their love story was marked by quiet certainty and devotion. While her parents were serving a mission in Argentina, Amanda selected her wedding dress on her own—confident, intuitive, and knowing exactly what she wanted. Amanda and Jonathan were sealed for time and all eternity in the Salt Lake City Temple on August 15, 2003, beginning a marriage rooted in faith, tenderness, and enduring love.

Amanda was first and always a devoted wife and mother. She poured her heart into her family, nurturing her children with warmth, wisdom, and unwavering presence. Her life was one of service, compassion, and quiet faith—lived fully and given freely.

Amanda is survived by her loving husband, Jonathan Volcansek; her children, Emma, Matthew, Sophie, and Isla, all of Hurricane, Utah; her parents, D. 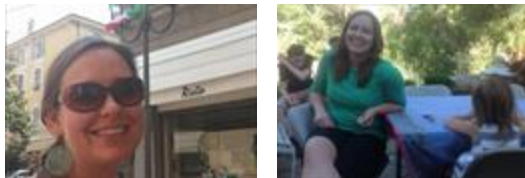
