



## Arthur Grant Jones

June 25, 1945 - December 7, 2019

With heavy hearts we announce the death of our father Art Jones (Arthur Grant Jones) in St. George, Utah. He passed away unexpectedly on Saturday Dec. 7th, 2019, due to natural causes.

The grave dedication will be held at 9:00 a.m. at the Washington City Cemetery on Saturday, January 4, 2020. The memorial services will then be held at 10:00 a.m. at the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, located at 591 West 500 North, St. George, Utah.

Art was born in Coalinga, California on June 25, 1945 and graduated from Mount Whitney High School, in Visalia California.
