November 12, 1939 - November 16, 2025

St. George, Utah - Bonita "Bonnie" Morrison Seamons passed away on November 16, 2025, in St. George, Utah. She was born on November 12, 1939, in Salt Lake City, Utah, to Afton Taylor Morrison and Earnest Merrill Morrison. She married Lynn Lee Seamons in the Logan Temple on September 19, 1958.

Bonnie lived in Salt Lake City and Roosevelt, Utah in her very young years and then in Hyde Park, Utah during her formative school years until she was married. She went to the Hyde Park Public School and then attended and graduated from North Cache High School in Richmond, Utah. She took some classes at Utah State University, more classes later at Yuba College in Marysville, California, and completed an AA degree in Early Childhood Education from American River College in Sacramento, California. She was a strong singer and could carry a tune in pitch. She and two friends from town formed a singing trio that performed at many events such as patriotic holidays, graduations and other civic occasions. She learned piano at a young age and polished her talent to a high level so that she served as an accompanist to countless choirs, classes and congregations. Later she learned to play organ and served as organist many times. She played at numberless sacrament meetings, funerals and conferences. She enjoyed homemaking and kept a meticulously clean home for her entire life. She was skilled in sewing and enjoyed making special outfits for her children. She worked in daycare, early childhood education, and music education for 20+ years in the Sacramento

area. She moved to the St. George, Utah area in 2001. She also worked as an ESL tutor in the St. George area. She taught piano from her own home for 50+ years in Yuba City, Sacramento and St. George. Many hundreds of children first learned their piano and music skills from Bonnie. Her passion was to love, nurture and encourage children. She loved to see children be happy and confident. She was very proud of our nation, the United States of America. She loved patriotic hymns and displayed a flag in front of her home for many years. She served in many callings in the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints including teacher in junior Sunday school, primary and young women, in primary and relief society presidencies, as a stake missionary, as relief society, Sunday school and choir accompanist and as ward organist. She loved to serve in the temple. She played organ prelude in the waiting chapel in the Oakland California Temple for years and later served as a temple worker in the St. George Temple.

She is survived by: David (Mary) Seamons of Brookings, Oregon; Jolene "Jo" (Cheyenne) Williams of Claremore, Oklahoma; Martin (Isabel) Seamons of San Jose, California; John (Linda) Seamons of Elk Grove, California; and Robert (Karla) Seamons of St. George, Utah; fourteen grandchildren; and seven great grandchildren; siblings: George Morrison, Ned Morrison, Kent Morrison, Sandra Adams, Sherrie Morrison. She was preceded in death by her brother, Dee Morrison.

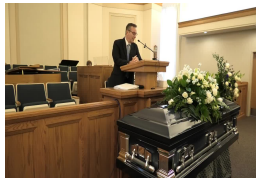

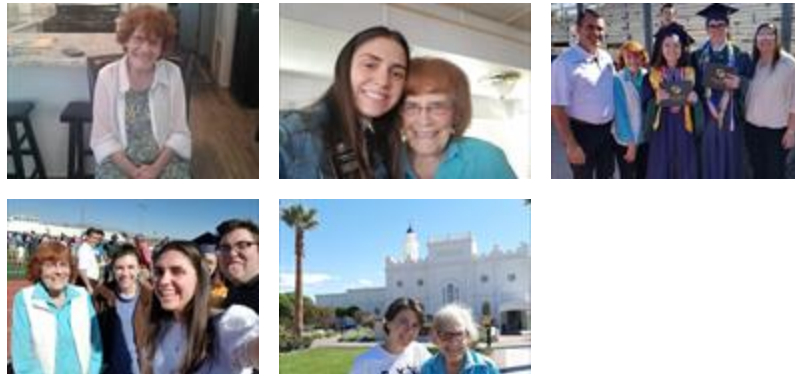

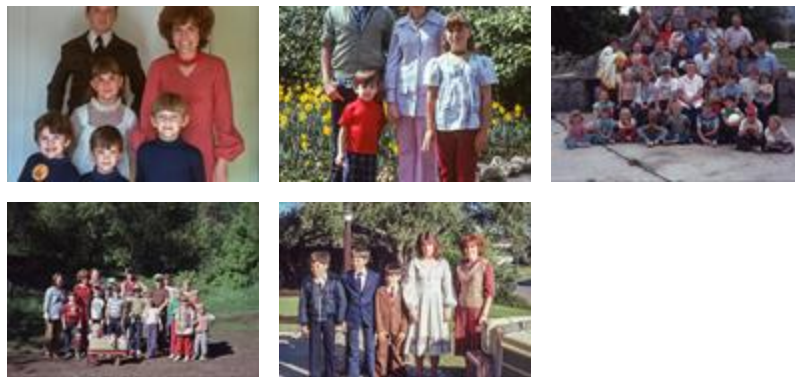
