



## Bowden (Bob) Bryner Kenworthy

February 28, 1919 - November 4, 2014

Bowden (Bob) Bryner Kenworthy, age 95, died early Tuesday morning, November 4, 2014 at his home in Riverton Utah.

Bob was born February 28, 1919 in St George, Utah to Bowden Lakin and Fern Bryner Kenworthy. He married Delna Barton January 8th, 1944 in Marysville, California. The marriage was later solemnized in the St George Temple. Delna passed away in May of 1991 in St George. He then married Flora Labrum Daley on September 3rd, 1991. Bob and Flora resided in LaVerkin, Huntington and, most recently, Riverton, Utah.

Bob grew up and was educated in St George, Utah. He served in the US military in Italy during World War II. He has lived in many places but his favorite memories were of growing up on the Kenworthy Homestead on Mount Trumbel on the Arizona Strip. Although Bob had many skills, including carpenter, brick mason and mechanic, when asked his profession during the last few weeks of life, he answered "cowboy". Bob was accomplished in many areas but is remembered most for his music. He played the piano, guitar, harmonica, accordion and most any brass instrument. Bob never became proficient at reading music because he was able to play virtually anything by ear. He played various instruments in dozens of dance bands during his lifetime. Bob loved the Gospel of Jesus Christ, was active in the LDS church since childhood and served three missions. He was a great harmonizer and

sang in multiple choirs and quartets. His favorite musical pastime was making beautiful music with his family.

Surviving family members include his loving wife Flora, three sons, four daughters, three step sons and three step daughters: Sheila Morris (Jim) of Fresno, California, Donald Kenworthy (Dawna) of Pine Valley, Utah, Carolyn Kendal (Mark) of Salt Lake City, Larry Kenworthy (Barbara) of St George, Kenneth Kenworthy (Brenda) of St George, Rosemary Baker (Byron) of Alpine, Wyoming and Laurie Hepworth (Howard) of St George. Step children: Marjorie Nobles of Riverton, Utah, Larry Daley (Linda) of Huntington, Utah, Karen Ison (Ralph) of Huntington, Utah, Elaine Morris ( Ephraim) of Coos Bay, Oregon, Michael Daley (Mary) of Columbia, So. Carolina, and Danny Daley (Tammie) of Rock Springs, Colorado. Survivors also include twenty-eight grandchildren, fifty-nine great grandchildren, fifty two step grandchildren, three step great grandchildren, Dolly (his dog), Tiger (his cat) and too many grand dogs to count. Bob was preceded in death by his two younger brothers, Kenneth and Glen Kenworthy.
