George Brent Crosby, 75, passed away peacefully in his sleep on February 9, 2015, at his home in St. George, UT. He was born November 3, 1939, in St. George, UT to Henry George and Emma Seegmiller Crosby.

Brent had a happy childhood as the youngest of five children and was loved and nurtured by his older siblings. He was a natural born leader and was elected class president in Jr. High, High School and Dixie College. Brent served a LDS mission to the Central Atlantic States. Following his mission he attended and graduated from BYU where he met and married Janice Taylor in the Mesa AZ Temple. They divorced later in life. Brent pursued a career in business and the service station industry. He was active in the LDS church, where he served in three bishoprics and was on the high council.
