



## Carl Phillip Hallenborg

June 2, 1942 - May 14, 2018

Dr. Carl Hallenborg passed away peacefully in his wife's arms on May 14, 2018, of cardiac disease.

He is survived by his devoted wife of 32 years Nancy, son Jason, daughter Jessica, and stepson Anthony (Lindsey) along with grandchildren Brianna and Braden.

He worked until his ICU admission. He would not retire, as he and Nancy loved the senior patients and Veterans, and had a clinic dedicated to these wonderful, wise patients.

Dr. Hallenborg was a triple board-certified Johns Hopkins graduate. He was a dedicated "Old School" physician, and would never retire.

He served in the US Navy on the aircraft carrier Intrepid in the North Atlantic in 1970, and a very proud veteran.

He is predeceased by his father Phil, mother Olga, and sister Janet.

He will be missed by not only the St. George community, but his Hawaii patients of 30 years.

A private memorial service will be held.
