Charles Kent Noble passed away Wed November 1, 2017 in Hurricane, Utah. He was born March 11, 1929 in Murray, Salt Lake County, Utah. He is the son of Charles Alexander Noble and Mary Katherine Hudson.

He spent his early years in Gold Hill exploring the old mines with his younger brother Jack. He also lived and attended school in Grantsville. As a teenager he learned to fly small planes and had many stories of his flying adventures.
