Charles Leslie Vickers (Vic), age 91, passed away on August 31, 2024, in St. George, Utah. He was born on March 8, 1933, in Portales, New Mexico, to John Girard Vickers and Virginia Modena Ratliff.

On July 18, 1964, Vic married Burma Faye Seale in Winterhaven, California. Together, they raised six children: Charles, Jeff, Cindy, John, Bob, and Melissa. Vic was also a proud grandfather to 15 grandchildren and a growing number of great-grandchildren.
