He worked construction with Cal traveling across the country doing jobs. He also worked in South Dakota.

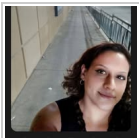

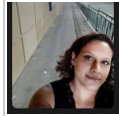

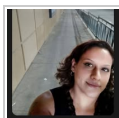
