Delmar Jacob Schmidt was born 27 March 1935 in Goessel, Kansas, to Daniel Franz Schmidt and Marie Gaeddert. He passed away 2 Aug 2019 in St George, Utah. His mother passed away when he was 4-½, and later, at age 11, his father married Kathryn Peters. The family moved from Goessel to Walton, Kansas, then, eventually, to Newton, Kansas, where he graduated from Newton High School in 1953.

Delmar joined the US Navy 12 Jun 1955 and served two years as a radio and teletype operator, serving on Admiral's Staff as part of the Pacific Fleet, followed by three more years in the US Navy Reserve.
