– Donald Wesley Dennett, Age 79, passed away on August 1, 2023, in St. George. He was born December 1, 1943, the same day as his twin brother, in Springdale to Wesley and Virginia Dennett.

He married Arleen Halsey in 1966 and they had four beautiful daughters: Jill Taylor, Kelli Nelson, Heidi Price, and Reagan Adair. After their divorce, he met and married Karolee Young in Springdale on February 1, 1986, and they were sealed in the Las Vegas Temple, on February 1, 1995. eternal companion. His dream job was raising elk, which he did for 12 years. He was an active member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints. He loved to share the gospel and took every opportunity to introduce people to the Savior.
