



## Elden Deon Hansen

Elden Deon Hansen, 88, passed away on June 8, 2024, in St. George, UT. Deon was born April 15, 1936, in Grace, ID to Melvin David and Grace Roholt Hansen. He married Beverly Ann McCluskey on September 4, 1959, in Los Angeles, CA.

Deon was the second child of a large and loving family. He attended primary and high school in Grace, ID, and attended Ricks College in ID, and El Camino College in CA when his family moved to California. He had a wide range of skills and worked in the special effects and props departments for the motion picture studios. He had a lifelong love for motorcycles and loved racing (until he was injured and Pince put a stop to it). He enjoyed family reunions, hunting, fishing, and spending time with his brothers and sisters. In the 1970's he started a new career as a house painter, which led to moving his family to Las Vegas, NV in 1976, where he built his own home, doing much of the work himself with the help of extended family members. After retiring from the Painter's and Decorators Union, Beverly and Deon sold their dream home in Las Vegas and moved to Hurricane, UT in 2012. Everywhere he lived, he was a source of support and help to all he interacted with, rescuing stranded drivers, helping friends and neighbors, and spending time in the temple.
