Elizabeth Hugg, 93, passed away on September 2, 2014, in the home she shared with her daughter and son-in-law. She was born June 15, 1921, in Monroe, MI, to Milan and Anna Kapetan. On February 16, 1946, she married Francis Eugene Hugg in South Lyon, MI.

She was raised, and attended school, in South Lyon, MI. An active Participant in 4H, she won first place in the evening gown competition for the state of Michigan and competed in the national competition, placing second. After the outbreak of WWII, she went to work as a secretary at Seamless Tubes, South Lyon, MI, in support of the war effort. She met Francis when he was home on a three week leave in 1942, at the end of which he proposed marriage and she accepted. Their marriage took place four years later, six months after he left the Army. They loved each other until the days of their death.

Elizabeth worked as a secretary for the majority of her life, first to provide income while Francis started the family nursery/greenhouse business and later to support him and their daughter when his health declined. She was smart, strong and capable and could grow, and make flourish, any plant she ever encountered. She was generous.

Elizabeth is survived by: her daughter, Cory Allender; son-in-law Meredith Allender; Sharon Salah Janssen; and Claire Elizabeth Janssen. She was preceded in death by her husband of 40 years, Francis, her Parents, and her three older brothers.
