March 27, 1949 - January 22, 2025

Newcastle, UT – Francis Clair Hansen, 75, passed away on January 22, 2025, in St. George, UT. He was born March 27, 1949, in Salt Lake City, UT to Francis and Julia Hansen. He married Jacqueline Evon Reidhead in Oregon on March 13, 1971.

Francis was born in Salt Lake City, Utah and lived in Midvale, Utah. He graduated high school and followed his family to Beryl, Utah. He was drafted into Vietnam where he was severely wounded in a firefight, permanently disabled and Honorably Discharged. He spent the majority of his adult life and retired as a Mail Carrier with the United States Postal Service in Cedar City, Utah. He served many positions in The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints as a member and spent many years of retirement as a Volunteer at the St. George Utah Temple. He enjoyed working with wood and spending time in the outdoors, among many things BBQing, gardening, hiking, hunting, fishing and camping.

He is survived by his children Scott (Son), Stacey (Daughter), Stephen (Son) and Andrew (Son). Scott has 4 children, Natasha (Daughter), Ethan (Son), Shayla (Daughter) and Kira (Daughter). Stacey is married to Jeremy and has 4 children, Connor (Son), Bethany (Daughter), Garrett (Son), Mariah (Daughter) and 1 Granddaughter Ellie. Stephen is Married to CeCe, and Andrew has 2 children, Dillon (Son) and Kaiden (Son). He is also survived by 5 siblings, Alan (Brother), NoraLee (Sister), Lewellyn (Brother), Helen (Sister), Iris (Sister), and many extended family members.

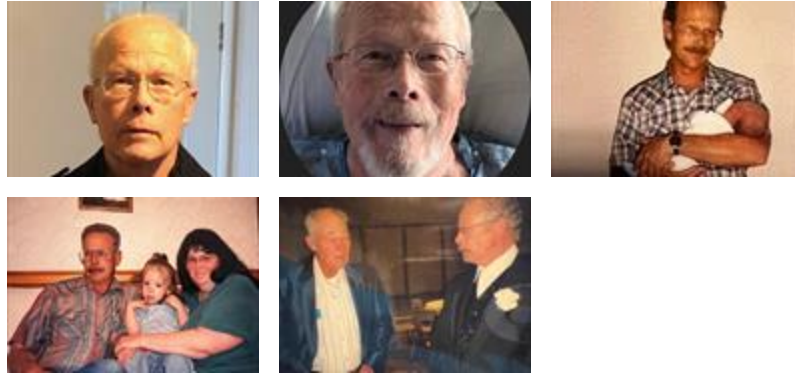
