



## Frank Davis Beard

Frank Davis Beard, 76, of St. George, Utah passed away on June 30th 2025 in his home surrounded by his wife and children. He was born July 14th 1948 in Pomona, California to Wallace Fredrick Beard and Helen Francis Fletcher Beard. He married Linda Jean Barrett Beard. 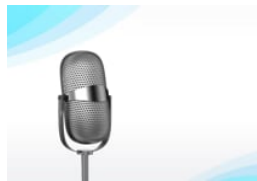

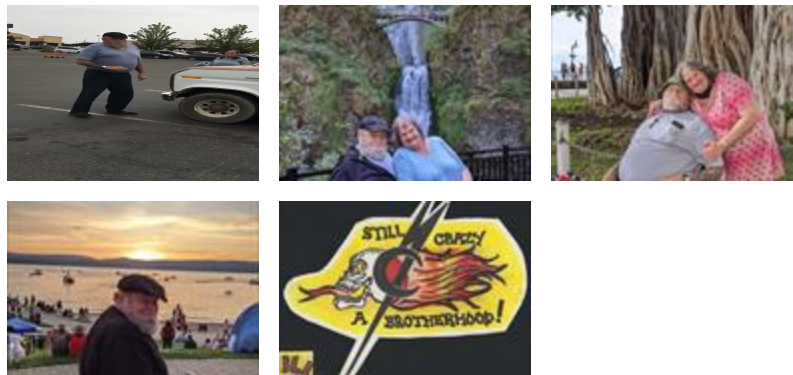
