Gregory Luis Dutra passed away at St. George Regional Hospital on April 3rd, 2024, after suffering multiple strokes, attempting to recover for many weeks, and eventually suffering cardiac arrest.

He loved to spend time with friends, just talking and telling old stories. He adored his new puppy, Missy, and enjoyed going out and racing his car with his friends in St. George. He loved his family and was forever changed at the birth of his first grandchild and with each subsequent little one becoming quite the softy and very loving and fun grandfather to a total of 11 grandchildren.

Greg is survived by his wife, Susan, his four children, Jessie, Zachary, Tycie, and Justin, and his 11 grandchildren, Landon, Bella, Margie, James, Cole, Allie, Ben, Grace, Jace, Lukas, and Zoe. He is also survived by his sister Glenda and her daughter Katie, his brother Steve and his children, Allie, Zachary, and Kaden, and his parents Glenn and Brenda. He is also survived by his much-loved puppy, Missy.
