November 2, 1929 - December 17, 2014

Helen Heaton Hall of Hurricane, UT, passed away Wednesday, December 17, 2014, in Hurricane, UT. She was born November 2, 1929, to William Carroll Heaton and Clarissa Hoyt Heaton. Her mother died less than a year later. Her grandmother and aunt moved in and helped raise her for about 5 years, until William married Grace Gardner about five years later.

Helen grew up and went to school in Orderville. She met the love of her life, Milton W Hall when she was 16 years old. They dated for about a year and then were married on June 12, 1947.

Milton and Helen spent their married life in Hurricane, Utah where she supported Milton in all his endeavors. Our mom raised five children of her own, and opened her heart and home to fourteen foster children.

Helen was an active participant in her church and community. She taught primary, and was the Primary and Relief Society President. She was PTA president of both Elementary and the High School. Helen was also the first woman to be elected to the Washington County School Board

Mom loved hand work of all kinds, her favorite being cross stitch and quilting while sharing her talents with family and friends.

Helen is survived by: her husband Milton W Hall; her children, Mac J (Peggy) Hall, KLynn (Virgil) Johnson, Darwin (Shirlene) Hall, Susan (Bob) Brown, and Sharlee (Brad) Reeve; 24 grandchildren; and 61 great grandchildren; four sisters, Gwen Adams, Mary James, Madeline Tait, LuJean Spencer; one brother, Dale Heaton. She was preceded in death by: her parents; one sister,

Lovina Hern; one brother, William Reo Heaton; and two grandsons, Virgil Wess Johnson, and Michael Ammon Stout.
