Helen E. Miessler, age 96, passed away on Friday, November 13, 2015. Helen moved to St. George in April, 2010, to reside with her daughter, Janice, and son-in-law, Jim Gregorius. She was born May 11, 1919, in Albuquerque, NM to Peter and Julia Apostle.

Upon her father's death, the family moved to Ironwood, Michigan, where Helen graduated from St. Ambrose High School. Helen moved and was employed in Chicago, IL and later met Walter L. Miessler. Helen and Walter were married March 6, 1943, in Kansas City, MO.

Following Walter's discharge from the Navy, Helen and Walter resided in Little Rock, Arkansas, until moving to Columbus, NE in 1955, to own and operate Miessler Drug Store. Retiring the business in 1986, Helen joined the Columbus Aquatic Center and was a dedicated member for 20 years. Helen was a member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Columbus, a Columbus Hospital Volunteer and volunteer for Meals on Wheels.

She is survived by her daughter, Janice (Jim) Gregorius of St. George, UT.

She is preceded in death by: her parents, Peter and Julia E. Apostle; husband Walter L. Miessler; her brother George Apostle; her son Robert J. Miessler; and son-in-law Jim Gregorius.
