She resided in Las Vegas for 41 years where she attended Will Beckley Elementary, Joe Mackey 6th Grade Center, K.O. Knudson Jr. High, then graduated from Valley High School in 1979. In March of 2006 Jeri and Rick Bennett were married, then moved to Cedar City, UT., where she lived until her passing. She worked in the banking industry for 16 years, then later going to work with her father in the steel construction industry.

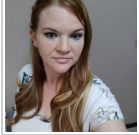

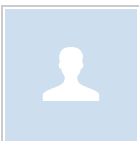
