Tawn loved all of her family, including her many aunts, uncles, and cousins, but she especially adored her sister, brother, and parents.

After high school she worked at Walmart and then Family Dollar where she was charged with opening stores in Castle Dale and Sandy, Utah and Grand Junction, Colorado. Tawn eventually returned to Price to attend the nursing program at College of Eastern Utah. In 2012 she earned her nursing degree. Tawn moved to St.

George where she became the Director of Nursing at Coral Desert Rehabilitation and Care. Becoming the Director of Nursing was her biggest accomplishment after her kids. Following her diagnosis, Tawn became a hospice nurse, working for Zions Way/Comfort Home Health and Hospice.

Tawn loved being a nurse and took great pride in the care she gave her patients. She connected with each of them on a personal level to give them compassion-filled care. Everyone who knew Tawn loved Tawn. Her friends and family knew she could always be counted on for a good laugh, honest advice, a road trip, or just a good hug.
