Cedar City, UT – John P. Tews, age 84, passed away on February 22, 2018, in Cedar City, UT. John was born May 15, 1933 on a farm by the city of Lewiston, MN.

He served in the United States Army for 3 years and was in a guided missile battalion. After his Honorable Discharge from the Army, he worked for Raytheon as a Draftsman for 13 years. He then worked for VETCO doing electric hydraulic design work. VETCO designed oil drilling equipment and the equipment was designed to drill for oil off of ships. He worked for VETCO for 15 years. After working at VETCO, he worked for a few electric design companies. He also worked for CRW in Carpinteria, CA building a mobile support system for the space station. He retired in 2001 after designing a revolving globe for the Japanese's Park in the Japan Sea.

John moved to Cedar City, Utah in 2003 and was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Cedar City. He was an active member and served as President of the Church Council. While living in Cedar City, he volunteered countless hours at The Happy Factory. The Happy Factory manufactures wooden cars and distributes them all over the world to underprivileged children.

He is survived by two sisters, Mary and Ruth and a favorite cousin, Phyllis,

and four grown children and four granddaughters.

A memorial service with full Military Honors will be held at Trinity Lutheran Church, 410 E. 1935 N. Cedar City, UT 84721 on March 3, 2018 starting at 11:00 am. A reception will follow at the church.
