Joy Lynn Jones passed away at her home on November 28, 2014, at age 64, from complications due to heart failure. Born to Cloyd L. Christensen and Leone Nelson, in Logan, Utah, January 25, 1950, she lived a happy childhood in Providence, Utah. Her family moved to Spanish Fork, Utah, where Joy attended elementary school. She was raised with five brothers and a sister. Joy graduated from Provo High School, in 1968 and attended Brigham Young University before she married Arthur Grant “Art” Jones August 29, 1970. Joy raised her family primarily in Washington, Utah, with prior short residences in Florida, Texas, & California.
