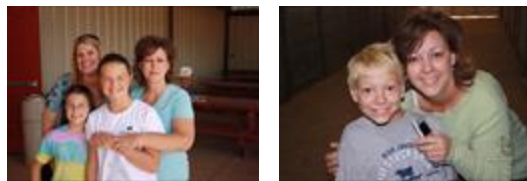
“ I worked with Judy at ALA. Her kind heart was infectious and her smile brightened the room. My thoughts and prayers are with her family.
