



## Judy Carol Goulding

May 3, 1947 - November 6, 2021

Judy Carol (Bowler) Goulding, 74, passed away on November 6, 2021, at St. George Regional Hospital in St. George, UT.

Judy was born May 3rd, 1947, in Cedar City, UT to Walter Alpine Bowler and Lillian Hall Bowler. She was raised in Enterprise, UT with her parents and 6 siblings and graduated from Enterprise High School in 1965.

After her high school graduation, Judy helped manage the Cozy Corner Cafe in Enterprise owned by her father, Alpine until she earned enough money to start her life's journey by attending LDS Business College in Salt Lake City. She continued her studies throughout the years at College of Southern Utah, Cedar City, University Texas El Paso, Pasadena City College in California and at the University of Nevada Las Vegas studying subjects in Nursing, Social Work, History, Culture and Sociology.

She had an extended career, mainly as a Medical and Administrative Secretary/Assistant in places such as William Beaumont Army Medical Center in El Paso, TX, USC Medical Center/School in Los Angeles, CA and the Salvation Army in Pasadena, CA.

She was married to Henry Orlik from 1967-72, John F. Haynes Jr. MD from 1973-1983 and Lavar Goulding from 2004-2006.

She traveled to and lived in Oklahoma, Florida, Ohio, Texas, California, and Nevada. She came back to Utah in 1991 where she resided in St George helping the community as a board member with Habitat for Humanity, helping children with their reading skills at her local elementary school and working in the emergency room as a volunteer at Dixie Regional Medical Center.

Her other pastimes over the years were reading, writing compositions/journaling, gardening, museums, cultural and sporting events and spending time with family and friends.

Judy's faith and membership in The Church of Jesus Latter-Day Saints extended her entire life.

She was preceded in death by: Her parents and her siblings Lesley A. Bowler, Christine Bowler and Olin Eugene Bowler.

She is survived by: Her children, Denise Orlik Osiecki and Robert Haynes, her grandchildren Patrick Osiecki and Jessica Osiecki and her siblings Charlotte Bowler Chambers, Randy H. Bowler and Ramona Bowler Jensen.
