Keith Holt Stocking, beloved husband, father, grandfather, and friend, passed away peacefully on June 17 in St. George, UT at the age of 85.

Born in Burley, Idaho, on October 18, 1940, to Clifford and Ann Holt Stocking. Keith grew up on a family farm near Paul, Idaho, where he developed a lifelong love of hard work, family, and the outdoors. He graduated from Minidoka High School in 1959, earned his Eagle Scout Award, studied carpentry at Idaho State University's trade school, and served a mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in France and Belgium after which he served for 6 years in the Army Reserves.
