



Kenneth William Seefeld

July 13, 1933 - October 18, 2022

Kenneth (Ken) William Seefeld passed away on October 18, 2022, at the age of 89. He was born on July 13, 1933, in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, and later graduated from Lawrence University in Appleton, Wisconsin, in 1956 with a B.S. degree. Ken graduated from the Wisconsin Institute of Mortuary Science in 1966. Afterwards, he was employed by the Wisconsin Bell Telephone Company from 1956-1966. After graduating from the mortuary science school he joined Seefeld Funeral Chapels, becoming president and retiring after 26 years.

Ken and his wife, Shirley, moved to St. George, Utah in 1994, and he was associated with Wilderness Log Homes of Plymouth, Wisconsin, and Anderson Lumber of St. George, Utah selling and building log homes. He built his log home and a Parade of Homes house in Bloomington Hills prior to moving to Sun River in 2006.

While in Oshkosh, Wisconsin, Ken was a member of the Oshkosh Rotary Club, Kiwanis Club and Oshkosh Area Chamber of Commerce. He also was elected to the Winnebago County Board and the Oshkosh Area School Board. Ken was active with the Miss Wisconsin Pageant for 17 years (1965-1981) as the business manager. His Masonic affiliations included Master Mason, Scottish Rite, York Rite and Shrine.

Ken was a member of Good Shepherd Presbyterian Church. He has been a member of the St. George Rotary Club and a volunteer at the Huntsman World Senior Games and the Chamber of Commerce, and was a neighborhood representative in Sun River.

He is survived by his wife, Shirley, and his son, Doug (Cindy) of Prescott, Arizona; and a daughter-in-law Nancy Seefeld of Spokane, Washington; and two grandchildren, Kenley and Gunnar Seefeld. He was preceded in death by his son, David William Seefeld (December 20, 2010); and his parents, Milton and Margaret Seefeld.
