



## Larry Nelson Myers

August 22, 1942 - July 17, 2021

Sadly we announce the passing of our husband, father, brother, friend, Larry Nelson Myers, age 78, who passed away at his home in Ivins, UT after a sudden illness on Saturday, July 17, 2021. Larry was born on August 20, 1942 in Lodi, CA to Virginia Louise Nelson and William Howard Myers. Larry is married to Jan Myers. Together they served as missionaries in Guyana, Trinidad, St. George, UT, and Otavalo, Ecuador before retiring in Ivins, UT.

Though born in California, Larry's childhood took him from Puerto Rico to Alaska to Calgary and places in between. So many of Larry's most precious memories stem from family visits to Mt. Pleasant, UT at the home of his maternal grandparents. Larry attended Western Canada High School in Calgary and the University of Montana, Missoula, MT where he graduated in geology.
