Loren Wayne Poole, 76, of Hurricane, UT, passed away November 14, 2014, at Dixie Regional Medical Center in St. George, UT. Loren was born December 14, 1937, to Dr. Fenn Poole & Maybelle Hansen in Glendale California, where he was raised with his sister Lynda Sue.
