I met the love of my life, Sheryl Webb, when we were just kids, 15 and 16 years old, when I offered her a ride home even though I didn’t have a car. This led to a lifelong love for the ages. We recently celebrated 57 years together and she and my family brought me the greatest joy. I never worked a day in my life but spent many years enjoying time running my company, Spartan Services. I was blessed to have the world’s best employees that became true friends. I had the chance to meet so many amazing people throughout my career which brought me so much happiness.”

Lynn was an active member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints and served in many callings over the years which brought him such great pleasure. The most recent being teaching the youth where he and Sheryl had such a positive impact. He was a lifelong veteran and was proud to

serve his country during the Vietnam conflict and afterward. He was incredibly patriotic and loved his country tremendously. He taught his family the same love and to show it by picking up trash wherever you were to keep America beautiful. Serving and loving people were his favorite hobbies.

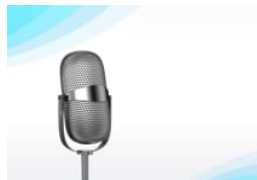
