Madalyn loved to visit new places and before her health limited her abilities to travel, she

toured in Italy, Israel, Germany, Great Britain and of course, most of Ireland. She was a

talented artist and loved crafts of all kinds. She had a love of astronomy and liked watching

lightning during a thunderstorm. She hated injustice and bullies and spiders.

Despite significant health challenges for a large portion of her time on Earth, she was full of

life and could light up a room. She lived her life with much laughter and happiness. She is

loved and she is missed. Madalyn is survived by her husband, two children, her mother, and

her two siblings.
