



Malakai Pua Fakahua

January 23, 1934 - April 9, 2015

Malakai Pua Fakahua, age 81, passed away Thursday, April 9, 2015 in St. George, Utah at Dixie Regional Medical Center following a brief illness. He was born in Pangai, Ha'apai, Tonga on January 23, 1934 to Akositafinau Havea and Salesi Misinale Fakahua. He married Latu Vava'u Finau in November 1964 in Vava'u, Tonga and in 1967 they were sealed for time and eternity in the Oakland California Temple.
