When he was younger he was a fancy dancer and traveled to many different pow wows. he started to sing with Water Deer drum group. Markie loved to play hand game, sing his traditional songs like sun dance, pow wow, Paiute round dance songs and he was the lead Salt Singer. He also liked to bead, sew, cook, and travel. He would drop what he was doing to help anyone. He will be greatly missed by all who knew him.

He is survived by: his mother Penny (Clarence) John; father Glenn Rogers; sister Amy (Dominic Manning) Wall brother, Jared Wall; nieces Dakota, Toni and Ashley Rogers, Amelia Ramirez, Emma Nava and nephew Anthony Ramirez. Many aunts and uncles

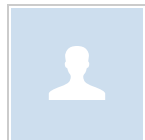
