



## Mary Faye Gray

October 10, 1940 - December 30, 2019

M. Faye Gray, 79 years of age, passed on Monday December 30, 2019 in St. George UT.

Faye was born October 10, 1940 in Dansville NY to the late LaVerne and Ruby Maples. She was the youngest of four children, three preceded her in death. Faye was educated in the Livingston County School System in Dansville New York.

Faye married Steven C. Gray in 1961 and two children were born from this union, Tamera Marie and Steven Philip.

Faye attended Culver Beauty College in Rochester NY and was employed as a beautician until the family moved to Sunrise Florida in 1970. Faye dedicated her time as an at-home mother to her children as well as a secretary for the Broward County School District.

After her children reached adulthood and left home, Faye and Steve moved to western North Carolina, first to Lake Lure and then settling in Horse Shoe.

Faye had a passion working for the school system and held several positions for the Henderson County Public Schools until she left in 2003 to take a secretarial position with a private educational foundation. In 2012, Faye and Steve relocated to their retirement home in St. George Utah.

Faye loved socializing, baking, knitting, camping, participating in the classic car club in Hendersonville, making people happy and being a "Mom". Faye was active in her church, the Good Shepherd Presbyterian Church, and was a member of the Women's Guild and the Knotty Knitters. Faye was also active

in P.E.O.

Faye leaves her husband Steve, children Tamera and Philip and their spouses, and her granddaughter Mary K. who will cherish many loving memories of her.
