Matthew Sevald, 38, passed away after a short illness on Wednesday, May 19th, 2021 in St. George, UT. He was born November 9th, 1982 in Detroit, MI to Paul Sevald and Eileen Alvarez.

Matt graduated from Catholic Central High School in 2000. In high school he enjoyed being in the band where he played the trumpet. After high school he joined the Marines where he was deployed to Iraq. He was medically discharged due to an injury. On June 1st, 2006 in San Antonio, TX he married Eva Thomas. They later moved from San Antonio to Northville, MI. After the birth of Peter they moved out to St. George, UT where he was a Dispatcher for the Police Department. He then decided to go to school to be a nurse of which he worked at Dixie Regional Medical Center until his recent illness and passing.

Matt's hobbies included Shooting firearms, Playing World of Warcraft, Tabletop gaming, Coaching his children's sports teams, and Belegarth Medieval Combat Society. He enjoyed volunteering with Peter at Boy Scouts and attending Trinity Lutheran Church.
