Mekala Ann Humphries 25, passed away suddenly on Friday November 4, 2022, in Millcreek, Utah. She was born to Jimmie “Trevor” & Suann Humphries on September 9, 1997, in St. George, Utah who were so happy to have her join their family. Mekala lived most of her life in Hurricane, Utah where she graduated from Hurricane High School in 2016. In high school, Mekala was involved in orchestra with her violin and in the Honor Society. She participated in two Miss Hurricane pageants and loved the experience. After high school she moved up to Rockville, Utah and lived with her grandparents for 6 months while she prepared to serve a mission for her church. She was called to the Baltimore, Maryland mission and served for 18 months. She loved her mission and the many people she served and was excited to introduce her family to all her new friends when they came out to pick her up. When she returned home, she moved to northern Utah to attend Westminster college for a degree in Sociology.

Mekala worked different jobs in her life. Her first job was in Springdale, Utah at an ice cream/sandwich deli and later at Subway. She then worked in Hurricane at Lin’s and Ernie’s and was later transferred to Ernie’s in Bountiful, Utah. She worked at the Cinemark Movie Theater and loved working there because when she had time off, she could watch and preview movies

Mekala's favorite hobbies were reading books, sleeping, and watching movies with friends or family. She enjoyed cooking and loved hanging out with family and friends. On occasion you would catch her out camping or on a four-wheeler. Mekala was the light in a room. Her sparkling personality was very contagious. 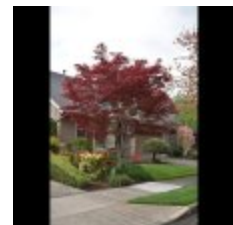
