It is with love and heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Michael Dillier Burbidge, who died peacefully at his home, surrounded by his family, after a courageous battle with Alzheimer's disease. While his journey with this illness was difficult, his family finds comfort in knowing that he is now free from the burdens of his mortal body.

Michael Dillier Burbidge age 79 passed away on September 4, 2025, in St. George, Utah. He was born on December 17, 1945, in Salt Lake City, Utah to Eugene and Alice Burbidge.

Mike was a devoted husband, father, grandpa, and friend. He is survived by his beloved wife, Dixie Swallow Burbidge, their five children, Garrett (Amy), Marci (Chad), Ryan (Lynne), Teresa, Angela, 18 grandchildren, and one great grandson. No one ever questioned the deep love he had for his wife, his devotion to her was constant and unwavering throughout their life together. 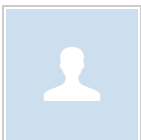

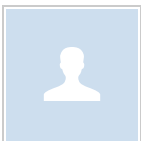
