## Michael Jeffrey Davidson 1975-2026

Michael Jeffrey Davidson was born January 14, 1975, to Michael and Cheryll. As a military brat, he lived all over including San Francisco, Alaska, Colorado, Virginia, and Italy. He was smart and athletic, playing volleyball and working as a lifeguard. He fell asleep during the ACT but still scored high enough to qualify to attend BYU a year early. He received a BS in Economics from BYU, a JD from the University of Tulsa, and an LL.M. in Energy Law from the University of Utah. He worked as a prolific litigator in construction law in the Vegas area and then as general counsel for various companies in Utah, including his favorite job—Holbrook Asphalt.

He served a mission in the Philippines until he was diagnosed with the inability to digest rice at which point he was transferred to Michigan. He served in a variety of callings but most loved working as a Salt Lake ordinance worker and as a nursery leader. He served and loved the Lord with all of his soul.

He married the love of his life, Rebecca Day, in June 2021 in the Oquirrh Temple. Together, they have 9 living children. He was a tremendous husband, father, stepfather, son, and brother. He loved spending time with his family, especially on vacation, and described his family as his greatest joy and

highest priority.

He is preceded in death by his father, Michael Jay Davidson, and by his three daughters and is survived by his wife, Rebecca, his sons Jasper and Henry, his stepchildren Thomas, Joseph, Crystal, Alex, Emily, Juliet, and Louis.

Mike ran a good race and returned home to his Heavenly Parents after complications from liver failure on February 1, 2026. Funeral service will be held on February 21, 2026, at 11:00 a.m. at the LDS church building on 675 E Desert Hills Drive in St. George, Utah. A viewing will be held from 10:00-10:45 a.m. before the funeral. Interment will be held at Tonaquint Cemetery at 1777 S Dixie Dr.

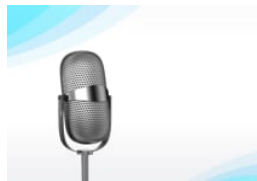

“ Was working at LDS Hospital in Salt Lake City, in the 'Well Baby Nursery' when i learned that my brother Michael's wife, Cheryl, was upstairs in labor with her first baby (Michael Jeffrey). My shift was supposed to end, but i got permission to stay another shift (from 8 to 16 hrs working) to be able to accept their baby in the Nursery, admit it, and do all it's vitals to make sure it was a nice healthy baby. Went upstairs to see how long it would take, and was surprised that she was delivering at that time, so rushed back down just as the Delivery nurse brought the baby to the Nursery to be cared for, and Was thrilled to learn that they had had a new baby boy. Was able to take care of my Davidson nephew, soon to be Michael Jeffrey in name, each day, and every shift that i worked while Cheryl and her son were in the hospital, which was such a thrill each day ! Three months later i went to Provo to enter LPN Nursing (at now called UVU), so didn't get to see them and their son after that. The next time i got to spend some some time with Michael Jeffrey was with his two younger brothers when i was married, and was living in Colorado Springs while my husband was AD-USAF, and they, for Mike had also a PCS move to Colorado Springs from Alaska, and Cheryl was pregnant with Michelle, and they asked me to tend their three sons, Michael J, Spencer, and Ben, while Cheryl was in labor with Michelle. Was glad that i and my girls were able to bond with their sons during that time. It was a sad time away from them when my husband got an USAF-ROTC leadership position at Utah State, and we had to PCS away, never to see them again while their family was moving around with the Army while they were growing up. While Michael Jeffrey was married to his first wife, Angela, I was friends with her on Fb, and she would post pictures of Jasper (named after the middle name of my/our father Halvard Jasper Davidson, M.D.), and of very young Henry, and they were so cute and all happy looking with their mother in the pictures ! Was sad when Michael Jeffrey ended his marriage to his son's mother, Angela, for i was sad for the boys losing her constant love and happiness (and maybe someday they will have her love in their lives again, for Heavenly Father knows her love for them) !! Do want Jasper and Henry to know that their Grandpa Michael J Davidson's

*sisters (the daughters of their Great Grandpa and Great Grandma Halvard Jasper Davidson and Marilyn S Davidson), Aunt Julia, Aunt Carol (\*me), Aunt Shauna, Aunt Jane, and Aunt Becky (Rebecca) all love you and do care about you, and how you are raised and turn out, and want you to know that your Heavenly Father loves you, and will help you both as you struggle with the loss of your father here on the Earth -- Be Strong, and of Good Courage, and he will send the Holy Spirit to comfort you, as you faithfully pray for his help and strength, and it will come in ways you might least expect !!
