Milton W Hall of Hurricane, UT, passed away Saturday, September 9, 2017, in St. George, UT. He was born November 2, 1924 in Hurricane, UT, to Lafayette Hall and Mary Bertha Wood Hall.

Milton grew up and went to school in Hurricane. He served in the Navy during WWII. He met the love of his life, Helen Heaton of Orderville in 1946. They dated for about a year and then were married on June 12, 1947 in the St George Temple.

Milton and Helen spent their married life in Hurricane. He provided for his family working construction and farming. He worked as the general manager and in other capacities of the Ash Creek Special Service District for about 35 years. He was the water master for the Hurricane Canal Company for almost 20 years. He served as the bishop of the Hurricane 1st Ward. Upon retirement of his employment he started a 30-year stint of various missionary endeavors for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. Milton and Helen raised five children of their own and opened their home to fourteen foster children.
