St. George, UT – Nedra Dalley Storey, 82, passed away peacefully at her home on January 4, 2017, due to complications caused by dementia.

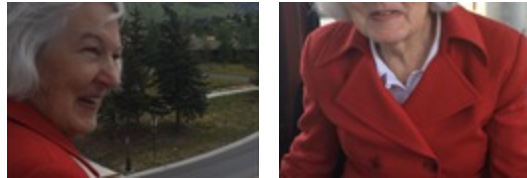
