



## Patricia Stewart Keyes

September 5, 1927 - February 25, 2014

Patricia Stewart Keyes passed away February 25, 2014 in Sandy, Utah. She was born September 5, 1927 at Newark, Ohio the daughter of Forrest V. and Margaret Grace Smith Stewart. Pat married Franklin Keyes in Ohio, and they had a son, Kevin.

Pat was the first in her family to join the LDS Church. Kevin followed and later baptized his father. The Keyes family was sealed together in the Salt Lake Temple. Pat often filled her car with fellow Church friends and made numerous trips from Ohio to Salt Lake City for General Conferences, all of them having a wonderful time.

She was part of the campaign committee for Ronald Reagan, working on one of his highway committees and driving all over several states for many years taking care of those responsibilities. After moving to St. George, she became very active with the Women's Republican Party.

Pat spent several summers driving to Nauvoo and working with Stanley Kimball and the variety shows presented in the early years of restoring Nauvoo. She had a beautiful singing voice as well as a love for the history of Nauvoo.

The family moved from Ohio to St. George, Utah in 2002. Pat was an

excellent and very detailed quilter. She helped establish a humanitarian quilt group that provided over 150 quilts to the Hopis and Zunis as well as sewing machines, fabric, and teaching tools for them. She was adopted into the Sacnsox Indian tribe by her adoptive Indian father. She wrote a history of his life 3 to 4 years ago. She continued to love and care for the Indians and the heritage that they have. Pat was always very generous with her time in caring for others.

Pat and her husband did a lot of family history research especially on her Stewart line.

She is survived by a son, Kevin (Bev) Keyes, 8 grandchildren and 18 great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband Franklin.

Funeral services will be held Saturday March 15, 2014 at 11:00 AM at the St George East Stake Center, 449 South 300 East St George, Utah. A visitation will take place from 9:00 am until 10:45 am. Interment will be at the Tonaquint Cemetery.
