Roach in Salt Lake City in 1951 where they had five children, Paul, Annette, Marianne, Merrill and Johnny. She met her second husband in Salt Lake City, Utah and was married on December 16, 1969.

Patricia graduated from Granite High School in Salt Lake City, Utah in 1951. Music was always a favorite pastime of hers, especially her love of Opera. She enjoyed travel, her two trips to Israel being among the highlights of her life. Pat had a wonderful sense of humor and loved new adventures. Mom and Rex found it refreshing to ride their motorcycle whether for a short local ride, or a longer trip. One such adventure was a three week motorcycle trip in 1975

which included Paul, Beverly and Merrill, from Salt Lake City up through Western Canada, down to Disneyland in Orange County, and then home. A trip we talked and laughed about for the next 40 years. She enjoyed trips to Lake Powell, including roughing it on the beaches at night and cooking over a camp fire. After Rex retired from Consolidated Freightways, she and Rex purchased a 5th Wheel trailer and hit the road exploring the western USA. For a few years they served as camp hosts in one of the Sequoia National Park campgrounds. They loved spending the summers amidst the trees and nature; also enjoyed meeting and befriending many fellow campers. Their love of Zion National Park, and other southern Utah parks, was a huge draw for moving to St. George.

A joy of our Mother's was spending time with her family and friends. One of mom's greatest gifts was her love of connecting with people. She overlooked people's weaknesses; she had an amazing ability to see their strengths and capabilities, then to encourage them to embrace those. Many people have shared with my brother and I that they called Patricia "Mom", she "adopted" several into her family.
