In lieu of flowers we request donations be given to your local Animal Shelter or the American Lung Association.

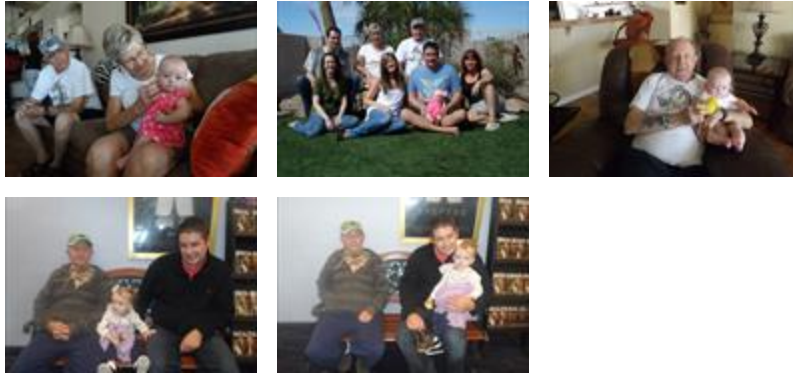
Family & Friends will have a celebration of life at a later date.

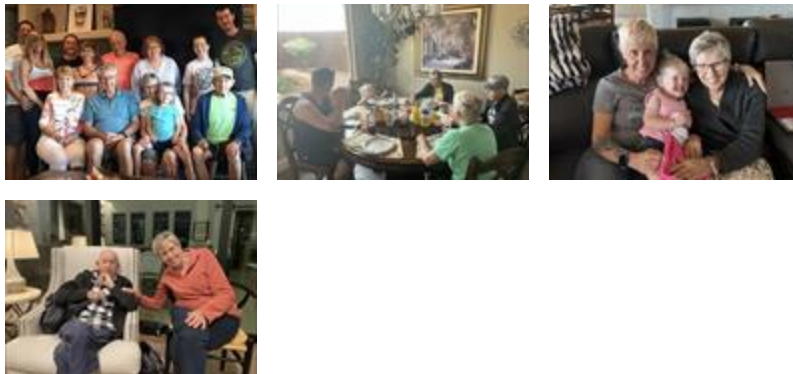
