Peggy L. Russell was born on November 19, 1936, in Long Beach, California to Roy and Geraldine Loomis. Most of her childhood years were spent in Long Beach until her family moved to Orange County, California, where she attended Tustin High School. After graduating, she attended the University of Hawaii, in Honolulu. She returned to California and married her high school sweetheart, Richard Humeston. Together, they raised two children, Cheryl and Steve, in Ventura County.

In the 1970's, Peggy became a member of the LDS church in Ojai, California. Later, she relocated to Logan, Utah, with her teenage son, in-law. She reconnected with a beloved family friend, Merrill Russell from Ojai, while living in Logan. They were sealed in the Logan Temple in September 1985, and enjoyed over 30 years together.

Peggy was employed by Logan High School for two decades before she and Merrill retired and moved to Saint George, Utah. Active in her branch, the two served a mission in Louisville, Kentucky. They returned and became ordinance workers at the Saint George Temple.

Peggy always enjoyed being involved with young adults, and most recently was a service provider to the community. She found a new love singing in the branch choir. She enjoyed retirement immensely, becoming a voracious

Peggy passed away suddenly at home, January 24, 2018.
