



Randall Lorin Haws

Randall Lorin Haws passed away peacefully on Monday morning, February 3, 2025, in Hurricane, Utah due to complications from cancer. He was 69 at the time of his passing. Randy lived in Southern Utah during the past six years, most recently at Heritage Home Senior Living, in Hurricane, Utah where he was loved and cared for by the staff and owners. Randy loved their companionship and the special treats that they would save for him if he was away during mealtime.

Randall was born in Santa Monica, California on August 26, 1955, and was the third child of Lorin and Barbara (Duke) Haws. He attended elementary and middle school in California before his family moved in 1969 to Utah where he attended high school. As an adult Randy lived in Salt Lake City, Bountiful, Murray, and Midvale, Utah, where he worked at various jobs including making window frames and caring for animals. Randy married Barbara Hodson in 1982, and they were sealed in the Salt Lake Temple two years later. Together they had three children. Randy and Barbara later separated but remained friends throughout his life.

Randy was an animal lover. He grew up with many pets but especially loved his cats. Randy really enjoyed arts and crafts and loved watching movies with his son Joe. Although he had a difficult life, Randy faced the years of dialysis and the last few months of cancer with a positive attitude.

Randy is survived by his wife Barbara, his three children Joseph, Ryan, and Aurora Snow, a grandson Trevor, brother Steven, sister Sandra Hodge, and

many nieces and nephews. He is preceded in death by his parents and sister Suzanne Potter.

A graveside memorial service will be held Tuesday February 11, 2025, at 2:00 pm at the Hurricane Cemetery where Randy will be laid to rest. 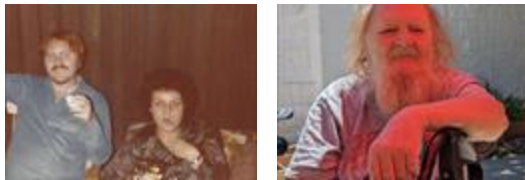
