September 16, 1938 - February 28, 2024

Sharon Amann returned to her heavenly home on February 28, 2024. She lived a good life of 85 years. Sharon had a positive outlook, even while living with heart failure for the last 17 years. Sharon was loved by all who met her. She was known both as one of the sweetest women you would meet, and as a woman with no guile.

Sharon was born Sept. 16, 1938, to Joseph Ate and Lucille Erskine Westra, in Salt Lake City, Utah. She had two brothers, Lamar and Steve, and one sister, Diane. She attended South High School and was in the pep club with her two best friends, Eileen and Joyce. Sharon grew up near Sugar House Park, where she met her sweetheart, Kent Amann. They were married on June 27, 1957, in the Salt Lake City Temple. They had 3 children, Randy, Rick, and Alyson, before moving to Pocatello, Idaho, then back to Salt Lake City, and then to Provo, Utah, where they lived for 43 years. Sharon and Kent had what she always called a bonus child in their 40s, Ryan. She and Kent moved to Washington, Utah in 2010 for her health and to be close to Alyson. She spent the last 14 years of her life in the sunny St. George area.

Sharon worked for over 35 years at the BYU Credit Union, which changed names over the years to UCCU. She was executive secretary to the president. She loved decorating her home for every holiday (which she picked up from her mother and passed on to her daughter). She also loved gardening and planting flowers. Her yard was one of the most beautiful on the block. She was a wonderful seamstress and made Alyson and her dolls matching

clothes. Sharon's favorite vacation was to go to Lake Powell on the houseboat with her family.

Sharon was a faithful member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints where she had various callings. She did a lot of genealogical research and temple work, which were a main focus in her later years.

Sharon is survived by her husband, Kent N. F. Amann; her four children, Randolph Scott (Linda) Amann; Richard Kent (Karen) Amann; Alyson (Brian) Stocks; and Ryan Todd (Amy) Amann; as well as her brothers, Lamar (Marjorie) Westra and Steven (Janna) Westra; 15 grandchildren, and 12 great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents and sister, Diane Mauss.

Sharon was truly a peacemaker and a valiant daughter of God, and she will be sorely missed.
