



Thomas Stanley Mann

December 22, 1936 - November 14, 2022

Thomas Stanley Mann, 85, passed away on Monday, November 14, 2022 at his home in St. George, UT.

Tom was born December 22, 1936, in Riverton, Wyoming to Clarence James and Margaret Monica Mann. He married Norma June Hansen in Milo, Idaho, November 21, 1959.

Tom was raised in Wyoming, Utah & Idaho. He graduated from Bonneville High School, in Ammon, Idaho in 1955 and started work at Westinghouse in Arco, Idaho immediately following graduation. Tom served in the US Army for one year at Ft. Benning, Georgia. He returned to work at Westinghouse and served in the Army reserves for eight years. He transferred to southeast Washington in 1974 and the family lived in Richland for five years and in Benton City for ten years, where they had a small farm. Tom and Norma, along with the three younger children, moved to Augusta, GA in 1989 where Tom completed his 40-year career in 1995 in Aiken, South Carolina at the Savannah River Plant.

As a young family, Tom and Norma would go camping a lot in the summer with the three oldest girls. They had adventures in Canada, Yellowstone and on the West Coast. Some of the camping trips included harrowing motorcycle rides according to the girls.

Tom loved all sports. He set a high jump record in high school, which stood for several decades. He enjoyed football, basketball, baseball, bowling and skiing. He also raced motorcycles when in his 30s. In his later years, he traded his motorcycle in for an ATV. Tom loved golfing most of all. After retiring in 1995, he would golf multiple times a week – sometimes multiple times a day. Tom said he could judge a man's integrity by the way he kept his golf score.

Tom and Norma enjoyed a trip to London after retiring then moved to Utah. They lived in the cities of Tremonton, Elk Ridge and Spanish Fork before setting in St. George in 2013. Tom and Norma served multiple Church service missions in Storehouses, Facilities Management, and Member Location as well as a full-time mission in the Idaho Falls Temple Visitors Center. They also served as temple ordinance workers for four years.

Tom grew up Catholic. He was baptized into The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints at the age of 26. However, he was more fully converted when living in Benton City. Tom and Norma were sealed in the Idaho Falls Temple two days after their 25th anniversary.

He is survived by: his angel wife, Norma June Mann, and six children; Tonia Mann, Dacula, GA, Monica Mann, St. George, UT, Cynthia Clark (Rich), Demorest, GA, Charles Mann, Roswell, GA, Jennifer Wuthrich (Chad), Greeley, CO, Jeffrey Mann, South Salt Lake City, UT, 13 grandchildren and 3 great-grandchildren, sisters Leone Priest, Pat Hershley, and Carol Stout.

Tom was preceded in death by his parents, brother Jerry Mann, and sisters Donna Larsen and Janice Capper.
