Cedar City, UT – After a courageous battle with cancer, Timothy Wayne Anderson Died on March 14, 2015, in Cedar City, UT, at the age of 68. He leaves behind his wife, Lori Winike; his daughters, Tisha and Becky Anderson; and his son, Mark Anderson.
