He later gained another brother, Ryan, when his father remarried. He grew up in La Verkin, Utah, but moved to St. George to live with his dad when he was old enough to get a job and bought his own car. He graduated from Pine View High School and got married to Rori Davis soon after. They had a son, Koston, and were later divorced. In 2011, he met the love of his life, Brittany Palmieri, while working together at a car dealership, and they were married on March 7th, 2012, in Phoenix, AZ. They had three sons: Jaxon, Teagan, Ashton, and one daughter Lennon. Brittany and Troy were sealed for all time and eternity on May 5th, 2018, after many years of preparation. They then decided to move to Utah in 2020. In 2021, their son Zeppelin was born only to return to his Heavenly Father 10 weeks later. Their hearts were truly broken, but through it all, Troy maintained his faith in God and assurance that they would be reunited someday. In 2022, their little girl Hailyn was born and brought with her much healing for the family.

Troy struggled with a lot of things, but despite his trials he always loved God, and he always made sure other people knew they were loved too. He was a magnet to the broken and loved to serve and help others. He'd truly give the shirt off his back to anyone who needed it. His smile lit up a room, his laugh was contagious. His greatest joy was his family. He loved to take the boys

camping and fishing. His little girls adored him when he'd get down on the floor and let them climb on him. We'd often see him cooking dinner with little Hailyn sitting on the counter "helping" him. He not only cooked, but he also cleaned the house, did laundry, and kept up the yard. He was devoted, loyal, patient, and full of light.

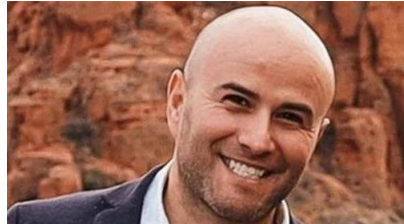
